
- Install in accordance with the current IEE Wiring Regulations and current Building Regulations.

Installation



- This is a Class I product and must be connected to an earth circuit.
- If replacing an existing fitting note down or photograph the existing wiring arrangement before disassembling for reference.
- Check beam and ceiling for any weakness before beginning installation.
- Ensure the bracket supplied is fixed to a wooden joist in the ceiling using screws supplied or use a suitable fixing to the ceiling that will support the weight of the fitting.
- The weight of this product must be supported by the supplied chain and not the flex.
- Adjust the chain to the required length; pull through the excess flex ensuring that no strain is placed on the flex.
- Connect wiring using provided connection block.
- Replace insulation sleeve before closing connection block.
- Position ceiling rose over mounting bracket and attach using provided screws.
- Carefully lower the product until the bracket and ceiling rose take the weight. Check and if necessary re-tighten screws.
- If in doubt at any time stop and consult a professional tradesman
